6. Can I have my sample analyzed by the Trust before filing a claim?

No. You need to open a claim before submitting a sample for analysis. See: www.zaitrust.com

7. Why is it called the "U.S." ZAI Trust?

The ZAI Trust Fund and Claims Facility is not a government sponsored program. The designation "U.S. ZAI PD Claims" simply distinguishes the trust fund from a similar trust fund in Canada. See: www.zaitrust.com

8. Is the Trust operated by W. R. Grace?

No. It is independent of W. R. Grace and is governed by a set of Distribution Procedures approved by the U.S. Bankruptcy Court. See: www.zaitrust.com
